"The 2011 Governor's Arts Awards"

Robert Highsmith

Robert Highsmith was one of seven artists selected for New Mexico's highest artistic honor "The 2011 Governor's Arts Awards ceremonies will be held on Friday evening, September 16, 5:15 to 7:00 pm at the St. Francis Auditorium, New Mexico Museum of Art in Santa Fe. The ceremony is preceded by an afternoon reception and exhibition opening, 3:30 – 4:30 pm, in the Governor's Gallery, 4th Floor, State Capitol. Both the awards ceremony and gallery reception are free and open to the public."

The dramatic New Mexico landscapes portrayed by Las Cruces watercolorist **Robert Highsmith** have inspired artists, art-lovers and critics alike, and have contributed greatly to the appreciation of his watercolor medium and his home state. Highsmith received his art training from New Mexico State University and the Ringling School of Art in Sarasota, Florida. He has had numerous one-man and group shows of his work throughout the country and is represented in private and corporate collections including the New Mexico Capitol Art Foundation Collection, Hartford Insurance, Southern New England Telephone and the U.S. Embassy in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia. Highsmith's work is currently featured in the travelling *Paint the Parks Top 100 Exhibit* and is featured on the cover of the February/March *Santa Fean* magazine. He is a signature member of both the New Mexico Watercolor Society and the American Watercolor Society. "Robert Highsmith embodies the best of New Mexico," said his nominator Carl Brown of Las Cruces. "The strong work ethic, generosity of spirit, and integrity with which his art is imbued is grandly reflected not only in the enchanting landscapes he portrays but, equally important, in the life he lives."
