Dale Hamlett, 89 years of age, died May 30, 2011. Dale was a Charter Member of the N.M. Watercolor Society. He has been one of the last surviving Charter members. He and his wife, Mozelle, have lived in Portales, N.M. since 1969, where he had been Professor of Art at Eastern New Mexico University. After retiring in 1987, he was given the title of Distinguished Professor of Art. Dale was a successful artist, exhibiting his watercolors in the U.S. and other countries, winning many awards, judging art shows, as well as giving many painting demonstrations and art workshops. Dale leaves a wife of 64 years, three daughters and families, three grandsons, and one great granddaughter
