Stephen Quiller is an internationally known painter who works primarily in water media, monotypes, and intaglio printmaking. He is best known for his innovative approach to water media painting: watercolor, gouache, acrylic, casein and their combinations, and for his use of color. He has written six books, all published by Watson-Guptill.

The emphasis in this workshop will be color and color relationships with some work in water media. The first two days are devoted to color using watercolor with some gouache. However artists choosing to work in acrylic and/or casein can work with those media as well. The last part of the workshop I will be working in acrylic in a water media approach.
